STANDING ORDERS FOR NALOXONE ADMINISTRATION

This standing order is issued by Dr. Gail Bradley (NPI #1952333247), Medical Director of Arizona Department of Health Services Bureau of Emergency Medical Services and Trauma System. The standing order authorizes any Arizona certified Emergency Medical Care Technician (EMCT), having met requirements of A.R.S. 36-2228, to administer naloxone to any individual with suspicion of opioid- overdose, in accordance with the protocols of this order.

Administer one of the two following naloxone products based on product availability and preference.

1	<p>For intranasal administration</p> <p><u>Dispense:</u> NARCAN™ 4mg/0.1ml nasal spray</p> <p><u>Sig:</u> Administer a single spray of NARCAN™ in one nostril. Repeat after 3 minutes if no or minimal response.</p> <p><u>Refills:</u> PRN x 1 year</p>
2	<p>For intramuscular or subcutaneous injection</p> <p><u>Disp:</u> EVZIO™ 2mg/0.4ml auto-injector, #1 Two-pack</p> <p><u>Sig:</u> Follow audio instructions from device. Place on thigh and inject 0.4ml. Repeat after 3 minutes if no or minimal response.</p> <p><u>Refills:</u> PRN x one year</p>
